



We were given these as a wedding present by a school friend in 1966 and she said they had belonged to her grandmother in Manchester whose family were in the cotton industry, not that that is particularly relevant.

I have tried to find out more about these little vases, H.12.1 cm, but with no success.

They are mounted in silver in a rather art deco style. The marks on the bottom do not tally with anything I can find out on the internet.

The bases are unglazed so I wonder if they have been ground down and the official mark removed and replaced with one made by the silversmith in a blackish colour. There are no wavy blue lines but COPENHAGEN appears in a washy blue.
